Grace Louise Creeger Wood Cook November 23, 1927 — August 1, 2022

Grace Louise Creeger Wood "Susie" Cook of West Palm Beach, Florida passed away on August 1, 2022 at the age of 94. She was born on November 23,1927 in Thurmont, MD. the "middle child", as she loved to say, of seven siblings. She graduated from Thurmont High School and attended the University of Maryland where she graduated with a degree in education. Thus began her long career as a kindergarten and first grade teacher. She taught in Frederick County, Md. at Thurmont and the Walkersville Elementary schools before moving to Calvert County in 1969 where she taught at the Solomons and Appeal Elementary schools. She retired after 40 years of teaching. She loved teaching all her life and instilled the love of reading into her young students. A role model as a professional educator, Susie continued to support public schools as a member of the Calvert Retired Personnel Association.

She was devoted to her family, and especially her children, Penni, Pete and Chip. She excelled at being a mother and was always cognizant of her children's situations and abilities. She was their greatest fan and supporter! Her other love was her church, Middleham & St. Peter's Parish, where she was a member of the choir, Daughters of the King and a Lay Eucharistic Minister.

After moving to Calvert County, she lived in Scientists' Cliffs in Port Republic until moving to the Asbury Solomons retirement community. In March, 2020 just as the Covid pandemic began, she moved to West Palm Beach, Florida in 2020 to live closer to her daughter. She was still her sweet and loving self until her death.

She was predeceased by her husband of 25 years, Charlie Cook.

A memorial service will be held in Thurmont, Maryland on April 22, 2023.


